

Madison Valley Community Council Meeting Minutes

6-18-14

President Lindy Wishard called the meeting to order. Introductions were made. There was not a quorum present.

City Redistricting:

We need to think of a representative to look to our interests.

Triangle Project:

Illustrations of the new design are available on madisonvalley.org . We have \$100,000 to start construction and bids are being solicited. The funds are matching and we need to get cash or volunteer hours.

Crosswalk:

Luc crossing: the tree on the south side will be removed, the sidewalk repaired and accessible ramps installed. Additionally, the sidewalk will be widened. Scheduled for late 2014. The design will be available later this week on MadisonValley.org.

26th & Boyer Crosswalk:

A new crosswalk is being installed. Neighbors, concerned about safety, have been campaigning for this improvement. The curb ramps will be accessible. It will become a four way stop.

A-Board Signs:

We would like enforcement of existing rules for the display of the boards. See MadisonValley.org for the regulations.

Parklet:

Harbour Pointe Coffeehouse will have a parklet constructed in front of the shop. This effort is to create a little gathering spot for our neighborhood. To view others for the concept: search on "Seattle Parklet." These are temporary installations, privately funded and maintained. Usually they are in place for a year or so. Sept Meeting:

We would like to decide the format of future meetings. We need to elect future officers.

Sip and Dine:

Tentatively scheduled for early September. It will be held as a cocktail party with small bites in the Sky Lounge of Aegis Living.

Greenbelt:

Burlap and wood chips have been delivered for the season. 200 new plants have been ordered for the fall. Parks Dept. has assisted in cleaning up the sidewalk and will repair the buckling in one area north of the clearing. Check nextdoor.com for volunteer opportunities.

Bastille Bash 2014: Saturday, July 12, 3-8 PM

This festival was started as promotional effort for the business community. After the economic downturn and the prolonged storm water project, merchants felt that folks just drove through and did not realize the amenities that were available. It has been wildly successful.
